The Galveston Park Board of Trustees Police Department supports the 77th Texas Legislature's mandate prohibiting racial profiling in Texas.

Our police officers work under a departmental policy that is consistent with all state and federal laws. The policy includes provisions for citizens to contact us if they have a conflict with a Galveston Park Board of Trustees Police Department police officer.

The Galveston Park Board of Trustees Police Department realizes that there will be disagreements, from time to time, with individuals that come in contact with our officers. We realize that confusion, different perceptions or possibly the timeliness of information could result in information that may produce different accounts of the same incident.

These disagreements between citizens and officers need to be addressed. We trust that the vast majority of contacts between citizens and officers are conducted in a positive, professional manner. The relationship between the community and our officers is based on confidence and trust. We cannot be effective without both the community and our officers working together to achieve this goal.

Citizens feeling that they have a legitimate concern may make a formal complaint to the Galveston Park Board of Trustees Police Department at any time by contacting any member of this department for information on the complaint process.
